Who is the audience and what is the purpose of my report?

Parent information?

Curriculum/Program evaluation?

Achievement and instructional design?

What do I know about my class's strengths and weaknesses? Distribution of achievement?

Group strengths?

Group weaknesses or gaps?

How can I group students for differentiated instruction?

Which students need small group intervention?

Which students need individual or small group enrichment?



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Score Types Reported in DataManager:

Abbreviation	Score	Use
SS	Standard Score	A scale score based on a continuous growth scale from K–12; describes a student's location on achievement continuum
PR/NPR	Percentile Rank	Use to compare student to others in the same grade at the same time of year
S/NS	Stanine	Percentile Rank converted to simplified number
NCE	Normal Curve Equivalent	Normalized standard scores that range from 1 to 99 with a mean of 50 and a standard deviation of 21.06
GE	Grade Equivalent	Describes a student's location on an achievement continuum in terms of grade and months

Iowa Assessments: Reports in Available in DataManager

- Student Roster selected sortable scores for class or grade level
- Multi-measure Student Roster combine and color-code scores across tests
- List of Student Scores (Scoring Service Print Style) list printable as PDF
- Student Profile individual student battery and composite scores with bar graph
- Student Profile Narrative (Scoring Service Print Style) individual profile with interpretation, great for parents
- Individual Performance Profile (Scoring Service Print Style)
- Group Roster scores for each selected group class, building, district
- Subgroup Roster scores for selected subgroups gender, race, etc.
- Group Profile average of battery and composite scores for group with bar graph
- Group Summary (Scoring Service Print Style) -presents average scores for group (*Scoring Service Print Style = optimized for printing from Dashboard or Classic)


