

English Learner Reclassification

Paper/Pencil and Hand Scoring FAQ

1. What score do the students need in order to be reclassified?

Student must score 40th percentile or above on both subtests

2. What norm period do we use?

2017 Spring norms – In the Norms and Conversion guide, make sure you are using the spring norm percentile chart listed as, student norms

3. Do proctors have to be certified to administer the assessment?

No, proctors do not have to be certified to administer the assessment, but they do have to be trained.

4. What are the accommodations?

Beyond instructions provided in the DFA, each administrator should refer to district LPAC committee for confirmation.

5. Can I test my 11/12 grade in one session for paper?

Yes, you can test in one session because they test level 17/18. However, when scoring you must follow their grade level specific conversion table.

6. Can I test grades 1 and 2 in one session?

No, you cannot test these two grades together because they are assessed with different levels.

7. Can I repeat directions for grades 1 and 2?

No, repeating the questions are not allowed.
